Yu-yuan Kuan is Professor and Head of Department of Social Welfare at National Chung Cheng University, Chiayi, Taiwan. A Hakka of Taiwan, he earned an undergraduate degree in political sciences at National Taiwan University, and MA in public policy and administration at National Sun Yat-sen University-Kaohsiung, and PhD degree in political sciences at the University of Missouri-St Louis, USA.

His research focuses on the Third Sector issues of non-profit organizations (NPO). He has done several projects with respect to the governance of NPO in Taiwan (including social groups and foundations), the role and function played by NPO in the social and economic development of Taiwanese society, the impact of the grass-root NPO on the development of civil society in Taiwan, and the development and characteristics of social enterprise in Taiwan, social performance evaluation of NPO. He is the author of a number of books, articles, and reports on the Taiwanese Nonprofit sector and welfare policies. Professor Kuan is a member of a number of academic associations on non-profit organizations, social welfare, and public administration. In addition, he has been chairman of Taiwanese Social Welfare Association since 2006-2010 and now serves on the Board of Taiwan Fund for Children and Families, the largest child welfare non-profit organization in Taiwan, and the executive board member and Vice Chairman of ChildFund Alliance, an international child welfare NGO.
