Yuegen Xiong is professor of social policy in the Department of Sociology, Peking University and currently a visiting professor in the Department of Public & Social Administration, City University of Hong Kong. He is the author of *Needs, Reciprocity and Shared Function: Policy and Practice of Elderly Care in Urban China* (Shanghai Renmin Press, 2008) and *Social Policy: Theories and Analytical Approaches* (Renmin University Press, 2009). He earned his PhD in social welfare from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1998. During 2002-2003, he was a British Academy KC Wong Visiting Fellow at the University of Oxford. He is the executive editor of *China Journal of Social Work* (Routledge) and editorial member of *Asian Social Work and Policy Review* (Wiley) and *Asian Education and Development Studies* (Emerald). His main research interests include social policy, comparative welfare regimes and NGOs and civil society in China.
