Yuegen Xiong is professor of social policy in the Department of Sociology, Peking University and currently a visiting professor in the Department of Public & Social Administration, City University of Hong Kong. He is the author of Needs, Reciprocity and Shared Function: Policy and Practice of Elderly Care in Urban China (Shanghai Renmin Press, 2008) and Social Policy: Theories and Analytical Approaches (Renmin University Press, 2009). He earned his PhD in social welfare from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1998. During 2002-2003, he was a British Academy KC Wong Visiting Fellow at the University of Oxford. He is the executive editor of China Journal of Social Work (Routledge) and editorial member of Asian Social Work and Policy Review (Wiley) and Asian Education and Development Studies (Emerald). His main research interests include social policy, comparative welfare regimes and NGOs and civil society in China.
