Sheila Purves is Director of International & China Programmes, The Hong Kong Society for Rehabilitation, (1988 – present). Since 1988, she has been responsible for planning, fund-raising, implementing, and evaluating rehabilitation training projects, mainly in China, many undertaken in the Society's role as a WHO Collaborating Centre for Rehabilitation.

Sheila is a Canadian citizen, with a basic degree in Rehabilitation Sciences from the University of British Columbia (1979), a Masters of Public Health in 1996 from Boston University. She is licensed as both an Occupational Therapist and Physiotherapist. She is honorary advisor, professor and lecturer to many hospitals and medical universities in different parts of China and she has undertaken consulting assignments for many organizations including WHO.

In 2000, she was awarded an MBE for her work in China on the Queens' Honour List (UK). In 2011 received a Doctor of Social Science (*honoris causa*) from Hong Kong Institute of Education.
