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Professor Thanos Karatzias is a Clinical and Health Psychologist and Professor of Mental Health in Edinburgh Napier University. He completed his PhD in 2001 in Stirling University and since then he has held academic posts in Stirling University and Queen Margaret University and clinical posts in NHS Lothian. He has long standing experience in health related research in a number of areas including psychological trauma and post-traumatic stress disorder, psychosis, substance use, eating disorders, stress and well-being and theoretical modelling of causes of mental health distress and co-morbidity. He has published widely in these areas. He is the Chair of the British Psychological Society Working Party for Survivors of Sexual Abuse (BPSSS). He is also a Consultant Psychologist in the Rivers Centre at the Royal Edinburgh Hospital.
