David Sutherland is the former Morgan Stanley's Chief Financial Officer in Asia Pacific, responsible for the company's businesses in China, India, Korea, Australia and other countries. Before his role as CFO, David spent more than a decade with Morgan Stanley in its tax affairs department in Asia; and prior to Asia, worked for Arthur Andersen, Cadwalader, Wickersham & Taft, Caplin & Drysdale, and the US Department of Treasury where he was the Associate International Tax Counsel. In that capacity, he represented the US Government regarding tax issues with most countries in Asia, including successful tax treaty negotiations with Thailand and Indonesia.

David serves as Chairman of the Board for International Care Ministries which works with the poorest of the poor in the Philippines and is also involved with the Lion King project, which assists street children in North Bali, Indonesia.

David has a law degree from the University of Virginia, a Masters of Taxation from the American University, and a Bachelor of Science from the University of Louisville. David was the national intercollegiate debate champion in the United States in 1982.
