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Dr Michael Hodson is head the Social Enterprise Incubator at Regent College's Marketplace Institute. He is a PhD economist and was formerly senior economist at the UK Government's Radio Telecommunications Agency and also headed up the government's business enterprise programme reform. As Head of Economics and Statistics at the UK radio-frequency regulator, Dr Hodson helped design the 3G auction that netted £22 billion.
