Edwin is a Board Member of his own family's foundation, the Simon K Y Lee Foundation. The Foundation is the charitable giving vehicle for Sun Hing Holdings Limited, which won the Coutts Prize for Family Business Hong Kong 2013 in the Family Philanthropy category.
