

Mr Francis Ngai Founder and Chief Executive Officer Social Ventures Hong Kong (SVhk)

Francis Ngai is the Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Social Ventures Hong Kong (SVhk), a venture philanthropic organisation dedicated to the support and nurture social innovation in Hong Kong. Since its establishment in 2007, SVhk has incubated over 20 portfolio ventures, among which, Mr Ngai co-founded Green Monday (an environmental and green lifestyle initiative), Playtao Education (an after school education for grassroots students) and RunOurCity (community engagement through running). Mr Ngai is also a Board Member of the Asia Venture Philanthropy Network.

Prior to establishing SVhk, Mr Ngai was the Head of Strategy in a listed technology conglomerate in Hong Kong. He graduated from the City University of Hong Kong and was conferred as an Honorary Fellow by the University in 2013. He was selected as one of the 100 Asia Pioneers by The Purpose Economy in 2014, a Young Global Leader of the World Economic Forum in 2012 and one of Hong Kong's Ten Outstanding Young Persons in 2011.
