The Master of Social Sciences in Nonprofit Management curriculum is the first of its kind in Hong Kong to enhance nonprofit developments in the Asia-Pacific and the world. It is designed to train leaders in civil society and particularly the nonprofit sector in Greater China and throughout the world.

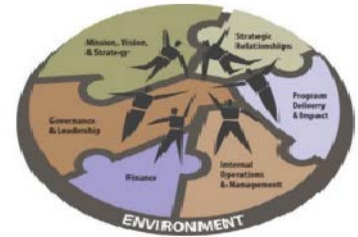
