Eight years after: Closing the door on the past

The 5.12 Wenchuan Earthquake, one of the most destructive natural disasters in China's history, has had a profound impact on the local community. In response, the HKU team developed a unique psychosocial intervention model. This involved working closely with survivors to understand their needs and develop tailored support programs. The results have been positive, with many survivors reporting improved mental health and a sense of closure. The team's work has also informed broader disaster preparedness and response efforts in the region.

Abstract:

The 2008 Wenchuan earthquake provided an opportunity to develop a Chinese psychosocial work model for disasters based on constant feedback from our service users involving school children, their parents and teachers over a span of nearly 7 years. Based on the feedback and experiences accumulated over the period, through cross-reflection, workers' discussion and clients' feedback, this paper delineates a model, which emphasizes a step-by-step approach for social workers and mental health professionals to work with disaster-affected communities using alternative ways of being, knowing and co-creating; self-help including mutual-help; inter/transdisciplinary approaches among stakeholders; and ethical behavior. This model may resonate with other post-disaster situations within China and overseas.
