

Professor David Smith Research and Emeritus Professor of Sociology Boston College

Biography

David Horton Smith (Ph.D. Sociology, Harvard, 1965) was the founder of ARNOVA (<u>www.arnova.org</u>) and *NVSQ* journal, and thus of the organised global field of voluntaristics. Co-recipient of the first (1993) ARNOVA Award for Distinguished Lifetime Contribution to Nonprofit and Voluntary Action Research and of the 2016 TIBS Perlmutter theory Award, he has bios in the *International Encyclopedia of Civil Society* (Springer, 2010) and in Marquis' *Who's Who in the World* since 2001. President of ICSERA (<u>www.icsera.org</u>), Editor-in-Chief of *VOLUNTARISTICS REVIEW*, and Research and Emeritus Professor at Boston College, Smith has authored/edited 20 published books/monographs, several international encyclopedia entries, and over 150 journal articles and book chapters. He currently is an Honorary Visiting Professor or Research Professor/Scholar at six universities on four continents, several of these being top universities in their respective nations.
