Biography

Professor Lester Salamon is a Professor Emeritus at The Johns Hopkins University and Director of the Johns Hopkins Center for Civil Society Studies. Professor Salamon has also served as Senior Research Professor at the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS) Bologna Center and Scientific Director of the International Laboratory for Nonprofit Sector Studies at Moscow's National Research University Higher School of Economics. Previously he served as Director of the Center for Governance and Management Research at the Urban Institute in Washington, D.C. and as Deputy Associate Director of the U.S. Office of Management and Budget in the Executive Office of the U.S. President.

More recently, he was centrally involved in the preparation of the United Nations' *Handbook on Non-Profit Institutions in the System of National Accounts*, the International Labour Organisation's *Manual on the Measurement of Volunteer Work*, and, most recently, the new United Nations' *Satellite Account Handbook on Nonprofit and Related Institutions and Volunteer Work* (2018).
