Professor Eli Friedman is Associate Professor in the Department of International and Comparative Labor, and Director of International Programs at the ILR School, Cornell University. His primary areas of interest are China, development, education, social movements, urbanization, and work and labor. Professor Friedman currently has two major research streams, the first of which looks at state responses to worker unrest in China and the development of labor relations institutions. The second is a study of Chinese urbanization, with a particular focus on access to education for rural to urban migrants.
