

Professor Tenzin Jinba Professor of Anthropology and Sociology Lanzhou University

Tenzin Jinba did his PhD in Anthropology at Boston University and has recently completed his postdoctoral research in the Agrarian Studies Program at Yale University. He is currently a professor of anthropology and sociology at Lanzhou University and research fellow in the Center for Himalayan Studies at French National Center for Scientific Research (CNRS). He works on border politics and identity, gender and ethnicity, state-society relations, and cross-cultural encounters. These issues have been explored in his newly published book – *In the Land of the Eastern Queendom: The Politics of Gender and Ethnicity on the Sino-Tibetan Border* (University of Washington Press, 2014). He is now preparing a new book on the making and remaking of the Sino-Tibetan border in history as a result of the engagement and convergences between the Tibetan and Chinese civilizations.
