

Getting to HKU

- **From the Airport – Airport Express**

1. When you arrive at Hong Kong International Airport, the easiest way to get to the city is by the Airport Express train, which you can catch from the arrival terminal. If your hotel is on Hong Kong Island (the location of HKU and all designated conference hotels), catch the train until the last stop (labelled "Hong Kong"). At Hong Kong station, follow the sign in the MTR station to walk to Central, take the train in Island Line and get off at HKU station.
2. You can buy a ticket for the train in the arrivals hall. It is recommended to purchase an Octopus card, which is a stored value card that you can use for all forms of public transport (except taxi). When you leave Hong Kong, you may return the card and receive a refund for the unused balance.

(C) From HKU East Gate to The Lee Shau Kee Lecture Centre

1. Enter Main Campus via stairs to lift lobby



2. Take the lift to LG/F and turn right



3. Walk straight to Sun Yat-sen Place



4. Head to Starbucks at Sun Yat-sen Place



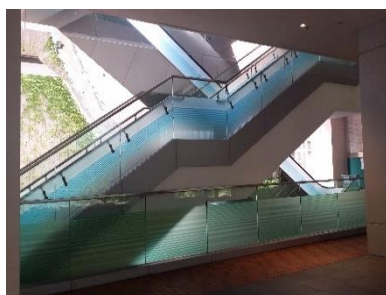
5. Turn right behind Starbucks and take the escalator up to Upper University Street



6. Turn right again entering Centennial Campus via University Street



7. Walk pass The Jockey Club Tower, take the escalator on your left down to LG/F



8. The Lee Shau Kee Lecture Centre is on your right



● **Driving Route to Campus**

From Western District or Kowloon (via Western Harbour Tunnel) to HKU

1. Take the Exit 1B (Kennedy Town) to Smithfield Road and Pokfield Road
2. Head east on Pokfield Road
3. Turn left onto Pok Fu Lam Rd
4. Slightly stay left
5. Ramp to HKU
6. Turn right at 1st roundabout to enter the carpark of Centennial Campus
7. Drop off at LG1/F of The Jockey Club Tower
8. Enter lift lobby at LG1/F
9. Lift to LG/F, The Lee Shau Kee Lecture Centre

From Admiralty to HKU

1. Slight left onto Conduit Road
2. Slight left to stay on Conduit Road
3. Turn right onto University Avenue
4. Slight left to stay on University Avenue
5. Drop off at Union Restaurant (4/F Haking Wong Building (Podium))
6. Follow signage to Centennial Campus
7. The Lee Shau Kee Lecture Centre will be on your right hand side

Parking at HKU

Visitors are recommended to use the car park of HKU Centennial Campus, which is the closest parking facilities to Centennial Campus at an hourly rate of \$20. Due to the limited parking spaces, visitors could also park their vehicles at Composite Building at an hourly rate of \$20. Please follow the signage to Centennial Campus via the University Street and visit The Lee Shau Kee Lecture Centre on LG/F.
