Professor Judy Wajcman is the Anthony Giddens Professor of Sociology at the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE), and a visiting professor at the Oxford Internet Institute. She was previously Professor of Sociology in the Research School of Social Sciences at the Australian National University. She has held posts in Cambridge, Edinburgh, Manchester, Sydney, Tokyo, Vienna, Warwick and Zurich. She was formerly a Centennial Professor at the LSE, a Visiting Fellow at All Souls College, Oxford, and a Visiting Professor at the Centre for Women in Business at London Business School. She was President of the Society for Social Studies of Science (2009 – 2011).

Professor Wajcman has published widely on the social shaping of technology, work and employment, and gender theory. Recent books include *Pressed for Time: The Acceleration of Life in Digital Capitalism* (Chicago, 2015) and, with N. Dodd, *The Sociology of Speed: Digital, Organization, and Social Temporalities* (OUP, 2017).
