Dr Clement Yongxi Chen is a Research Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Law of The University of Hong Kong. He received his legal education from HKU (PhD), University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne and Sun Yat-sen University (LLM and LLB). He is a Research Fellow at the Centre for Public Law, Sun Yat-sen University, and was a WYNG Visiting Fellow at the Centre of Genomics and Policy, McGill University.

Dr Chen research interests include law and data science, Chinese public law and comparative administrative law. He participated in the drafting of China's first local legislation on freedom of information. His thesis on the judicial protection of freedom of information in China was awarded the Intersentia Prize for the Best PhD Thesis in Law.
