Professor Samson Tse is from the Department of Social Work and Social Administration at The University of Hong Kong. Professor Tse holds honorary/visiting professorial positions in several universities such as The University of British Columbia (Health Research Associate, 2006-present), The University of Auckland (2010-present), The University of Melbourne (2011-present) and Yale University (2013, summer). He has served in government, and non-government organization advisory committees in New Zealand, Singapore and Hong Kong. He has acted as a consultant for internet-based mental health promotion or intervention projects.

Professor Tse has expertise in examining the complex mechanisms of recovery from severe and persistent mental illness like bipolar disorder and gambling disorder. He and his multidisciplinary teams have adopted a holistic perspective to emphasize strength and hope in assisting people to reclaim meaningful life roles and to live productive lives even with the “condition”. Professor Tse has been successful in securing research funding for his projects and his program of research has resulted in over 140 scholarly publications including peer-reviewed journal articles, book chapters, and edited books. His publications have appeared in *Bipolar Disorders*, *World Psychiatry*, *Psychiatric Services*, *Addiction*, *Administration and Policy in Mental Health and Mental Health Services Research*, *International Review of Psychiatry*, *Psychiatry: Interpersonal and Biological Processes* and *The Journals of Gerontology: Psychological Sciences and Social Sciences*.
