

LIMITATION

DEVELOPMENT

- Setting up a urban farm inside the building requires the consensus and approval of property owners, some conservative owners may feel reluctant to do so regarding different aspects of concerns
- · Setting up urban farms requires proper site suitability, well drained system, enough affordability of the rooftop, and enough logistic support
- Many urban farms restrict public access due to safety and security concerns

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
