- 3. Students who wish to take the following courses are required to send an email to the course offering department for approval <u>two weeks</u> before the course enrollment period. Upon approval, the students should forward the approval email to the Faculty Office via email (<u>socscug@hku.hk</u>) and the Faculty Office will enroll the course for you.
