Students may also opt for a double major in multidisciplinary options such as Cognitive Science, Counselling, Criminology, Media and Cultural Studies, Urban Governance, Neuroscience and other majors offered by the University. Students can choose to combine a major with one or two minors.

3. Students are requested to select not more than two courses from each area of inquiry

4. Students are requested to choose the introductory pre-requisites courses offered by the core departments under the Faculty, excluding your major department. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

5. For students majoring in Psychology, you are required to select 2 courses from First Stream and 3 courses from Second Stream. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

6. For students majoring in Social Work and Social Administration, you should select 1 course under category a 'Contemporary social issues' and 2 courses under category b 'Policy issues and social administration' of the course list. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

7. For students majoring in Sociology, you are required to select 2 courses from the advanced core course list. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

8. Students are requested to complete 12 credits of Social Innovation Requirement and 12 credits of Global Citizenship Requirement.

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2. Each course carries 6 credits, unless specified otherwise.

3. Students are requested to choose the introductory pre-requisites courses offered by the core departments under the Faculty, excluding your major department. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

4. For students majoring in Urban Governance, you are required to select 3 courses from the advanced core course list. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

5. For students majoring in Media and Cultural Studies, you should select not more than 2 courses from any single department from the advanced course list. Please refer to the BSocSc programme syllabus at the Faculty website for detailed requirements.

6. Students should bear in mind the pre-requisite requirements for courses listed in the "Disciplinary Electives" (See below courses), and take the relevant requisite courses as necessary. Students are reminded to take note that you may need to use 6 to 18 credits

for taking relevant pre-requisite(s) which are counted as free elective(s) outside neuroscience curriculum. However, if you have already completed the pre-requisite(s) concerned at you first major, the implication of pre-requisite requirements in Neuroscience Major on students' course selection and study load would be minimized.

a) Pre-requisites of BIOL3105: BIOL2103/BIOL2220/BIOC2600 [(Pre-requisites of BIOL2103&BIOL2220: BIOL1110) & (Pre-requisite of BIOC2600: BIOC1600/BIOL1110/ENGG1207)]

b) Pre-requisites of BBMS3011: BBMS2006(Pre-requisite of BBMS2006: BBMS1001)

c) Pre-requisite of BBMS2003: BBMS1001/BIOC1600

d) Pre-requisite of MEDE3501: MEDE2500/MEDE2201/MEDE2203/ELEC3241

e) Pre-requisites of PSYC4101 Independent study in neuroscience: PSYC2060[#] and PSYC2101-Foundation of neuroscience (Pre-requisites of PSYC2060: PSYC1001 and PSYC1004)

[#]A waiver on pre-requisite course (PSYC2060) will be granted for students taking [PSYC4101 Independent Study in Neuroscience] if the students have taken similar research methods course in their first major (equivalent to PSYC2060). Students shall approach the Department of Psychology for application.]

f) Students must complete two prerequisite courses at the introductory level, and the taking of such courses is subject to academic advising and prior approval of the Department of Psychology. First and foremost, these 12 credits must be utilized to

fulfill the prerequisite requirements of "Disciplinary Electives", and also to ensure that all components of the major are academically coherent.

7. For selection of disciplinary electives under "Second Stream", students should select at least one course that is not from the Department of Psychology

8. Each course carries 6 credits, however, if students take PSYC4101 Independent Study in Neuroscience, the course carries 12 credits
