Biography

Professor Shuzhuo Li is Changjiang Professor of Population and Social Policy Studies in the School of Public Policy and Administration at the Xi'an Jiaotong University. He is also the Director of the Institute for Population and Development Studies, Director of the Center for Population and Social Policy Research, Co-director of the Center for Aging and Health Research, Co-director of the Shaanxi Migration and Relocation Research Center, Chief Scientist of the Shaanxi Collaborative Innovation Center for Social Governance and Social Policy Research, and consulting professor at the Morrison Institute for Population and Resource Studies, Stanford University.

Professor Li's research focuses on population and social development as well as public policies in contemporary transitional China, including population policies, aging and old-age support, rural-urban migrants and social integration, gender imbalance and sustainable social development, ecosystem services and human wellbeing. He has published numerous papers and books, and has won many honors and prizes, including the Fudan Management Award in 2011.
