Biography

Professor Leslie is the Director of the UNSW Global Water Institute, and a Professor in the School of Chemical Engineering at UNSW Sydney. Prior to joining UNSW, he worked in the public and private sector on water treatment, reuse and desalination projects in Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Hong Kong and the United States. His work covers the application of membranes processes in municipal, industrial and agricultural applications. His experience includes the NEWater recycling project for the Singapore Public Utilities Board and the Groundwater Water Replenishment System at the Orange County Water District (OCWD) in California. He served on the Desalination Guidelines Technical Committee for the World Health Organisation, the Water Issue Committee for the National Health and Medical Research Council and the Independent Advisory Panel for the Orange County Groundwater Replenishment Project.
