Biography

Dr Janet H Hsiao is Head of the Department of Psychology and Associate Professor at The University of Hong Kong (HKU). She is a principal investigator of the State Key Laboratory of Brain and Cognitive Sciences at HKU. Before joining HKU, she was a postdoctoral researcher in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering and the Temporal Dynamics of Learning Center (TDLC) at the University of California, San Diego and worked with Professor Gary Cottrell. She received the PhD degree in Informatics from the University of Edinburgh in 2006, the MSc degree in Computing Science from Simon Fraser University in 2002, and the BSc degree in Computer Science from National Taiwan University in 1999.

Dr Hsiao's research interests include cognitive science, computational modeling, eye movement analysis, and learning and expertise acquisition. She was a recipient of the Best Language Modeling Paper Prize from the Cognitive Science Society in 2006 and the Early Career Award from the Research Grants Council of Hong Kong in 2012. She has served on Annual Meeting Program Committee of the Cognitive Science Society since 2016 and is currently an Associate Editor of its flagship journal *Cognitive Science*. She is also currently a Section Editor for *Cognition*.
