## **Biography**

Professor Chao Liu is Professor at State Key Laboratory of Cognitive Neuroscience and Learning and IDG/ McGovern Institute for Brain Science, Faculty of Psychology at Beijing Normal University. Currently, he is a member of the Emotion and Health Psychology Professional Committee and Cultural Psychology Professional Committee in Chinese Psychological Society, Social Cognition Branch of Chinese Society for Cognitive Science, China Branch of International Society for Social Neuroscience, and member of Artificial Psychology and Artificial Emotion Special Committee of Chinese Association for Artificial Intelligence. He received his PhD degree in Psychology at University of Michigan, Ann Arbor.

Professor Liu's research interest includes emotion and social cognitive neuroscience, mainly focusing on the regulatory role and brain mechanism of emotion in social cognition, especially in moral cognition and its application in education, management, and public safety. He serves as Associate Editor of *Frontiers in Decision Neuroscience Journal*. He has hosted many national research projects, including National Social Science Key Projects, key projects from China National Key R&D Program, National Ten Thousand Talent Program.
