Professor Jian Li is researcher at School of Psychological and Cognitive Sciences, and IDG/McGovern Institute for Brain Science at Peking University. He has received the Gruber International Neurobiology Research Award (2011), the Seeking Scholar Foundation's Outstanding Young Scholar Award (2014), and Outstanding Young Investigator Program from the National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC), and grants from the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) 973 Program.

Professor Li's research interests are focused on the cognitive and neural mechanisms of reward learning and value decision making in human. He also serves as an editorial board member of the *Journal of Psychology*, *The Psych Journal*, *Scientific Reports*, *Discover Psychology*, *Journal of Neuroscience*, *Psychology and Economics*, and other domestic and international academic journals.
