

Professor Ruolei Gu Institute of Psychology Chinese Academy of Sciences

Biography

Professor Ruolei Gu is researcher in the Institute of Psychology at Chinese Academy of Sciences. He is member of the EEG Special Committee of the Chinese Psychological Society. He graduated from the Institute of Brain and Cognitive Sciences, Beijing Normal University. He is a visiting scholar at the University of Kentucky and the State University of New York at Stony Brook.

Professor Gu's main interest is to study the brain mechanisms of mental processes such as decision making and emotional processing from the temporal dimension. He has published more than 100 peer-reviewed papers in *Neurosci Biobehav Rev, J Neurosci, Neuroimage, Psychological Medicine* and other journals, including more than 50 first or corresponding author papers. He has hosted three National Natural Science Foundation projects and participated in key international collaborative projects and major projects of National Social Science. He received the Second Prize of Natural Science of Guangdong Province, the Teaching Achievement Award of Chinese Academy of Sciences, the Silver Prize of NUST Leading Geese, and the Excellent Postgraduate Course Award of NUST.
