

Professor Xianchun Li School of Psychology and Cognitive Sciences East China Normal University

Biography

Professor Xianchun Li is Associate Dean of the School of Psychology and Cognitive Sciences at East China Normal University. He joined School of Psychology and Cognitive Science at East China Normal University in 2009. He was selected for Shanghai Pujiang Talent Program. He is a member of Chinese Psychological Society and Shanghai Psychological Society. He received his PhD degree from East China Normal University in 2005 and then completed a post-doc at Johns Hopkins University, USA.

Using multi-modal brain techniques (fNIRS, EEG/ERP, fMRI, tACS), Professor Li's research mainly includes: (1) Neural mechanism of higher social cognitive activities (such as cooperation, social norms, social communication and social interaction); (2) the psychological and brain mechanisms of social dysfunction in people with mental illness (e.g., schizophrenia, autism, etc.) from the perspective of interpersonal interaction. He has hosted and undertaken six national and provincial scientific research projects, published more than 30 academic papers in *PNAS*, *NeuroImage*, *Human Brain Mapping*, *Psychological Journal*, and other top academic journals.
