## **Biography**

Dr Austin Strange is Assistant Professor in the Department of Politics and Public Administration at The University of Hong Kong. He holds a PhD from Harvard University, an MA from Zhejiang University, and a BA from the College of William & Mary.

Dr Strange's research examines China's contemporary and historical roles in the world economy, with a particular focus on China's approach to global development. He is co-author of *Banking on Beijing: The Aims and Impacts of China's Overseas Development Program* (forthcoming, Cambridge University Press). His research is published or forthcoming in peer-reviewed journals like *American Economic Journal: Economic Policy, International Studies Quarterly, Journal of Conflict Resolution*, and the *Journal of Contemporary China*.
