He is also coordinating knowledge exchange activities such as the Certified Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST) Practitioner Training Course in collaboration with the International CST Centre of University College London.

Dr Choy is interested in understanding family care provided by multiple family members and other informal carers as well as ways for improving wellbeing of caregiving family as a holistic unit.
