Biography

Professor Leafia Ye is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Sociology at the University of Toronto. She is also a faculty affiliate at the Global Migration Lab at the Munk School of Global Affairs & Public Policy.

She is a sociologist, social demographer and scholar of international migration and aging, her work identifies barriers to immigrant integration into host societies by documenting how and socioeconomics and health inequalities evolve over the life course.

She has particularly strong expertise in the well-being of immigrants in the U.S. and Canada as they navigate aging and retirement. She has empirically used a wide range of quantitative methods to analyze administrative and survey datasets. Her work has most recently appeared in Social Forces, Population and Development Review, Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies, RSF: The Russell Sage Foundation Journal of the Social Sciences, Socius: Sociological Research for a Dynamic World, and Advances in Medical Sociology.
