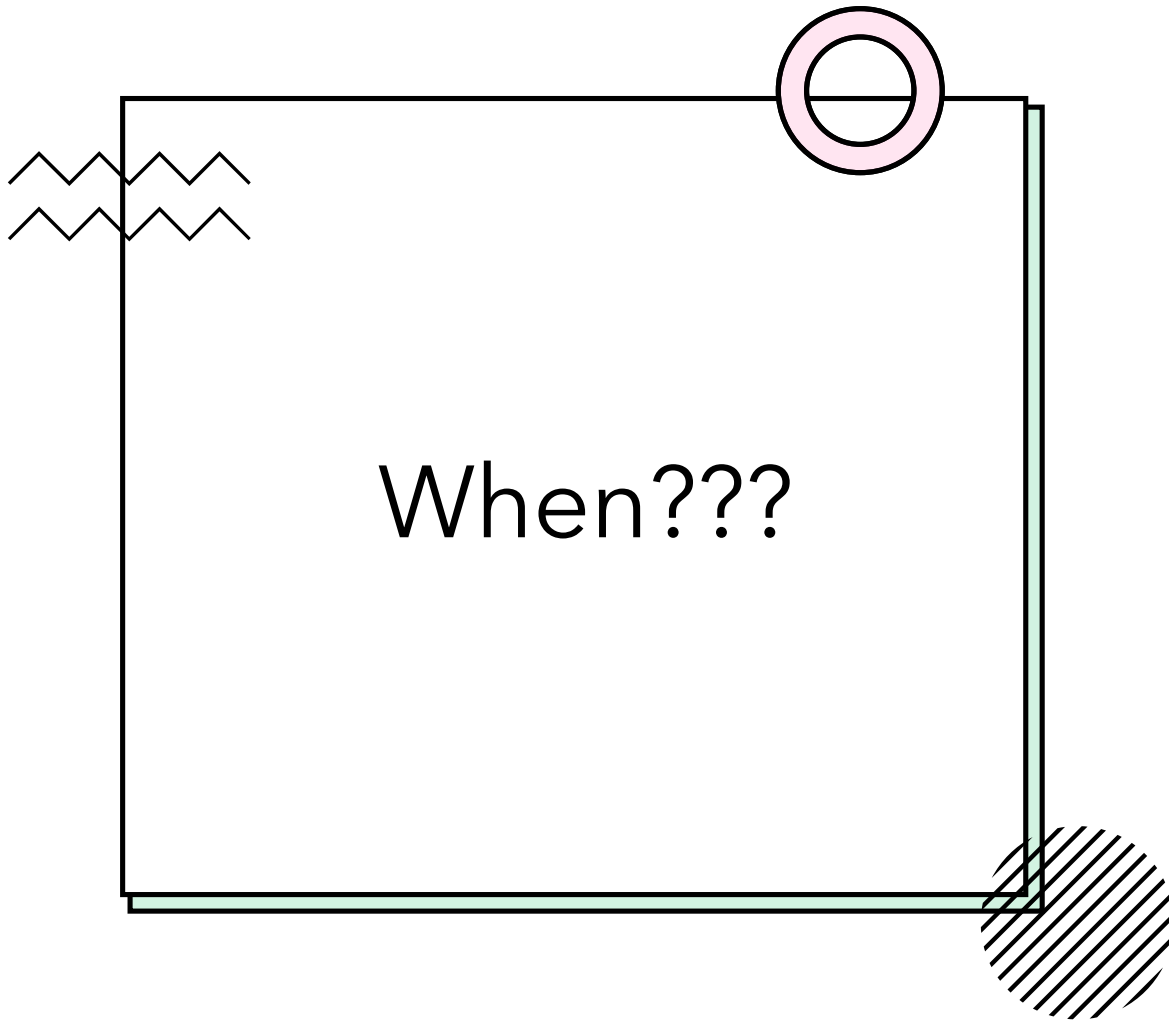

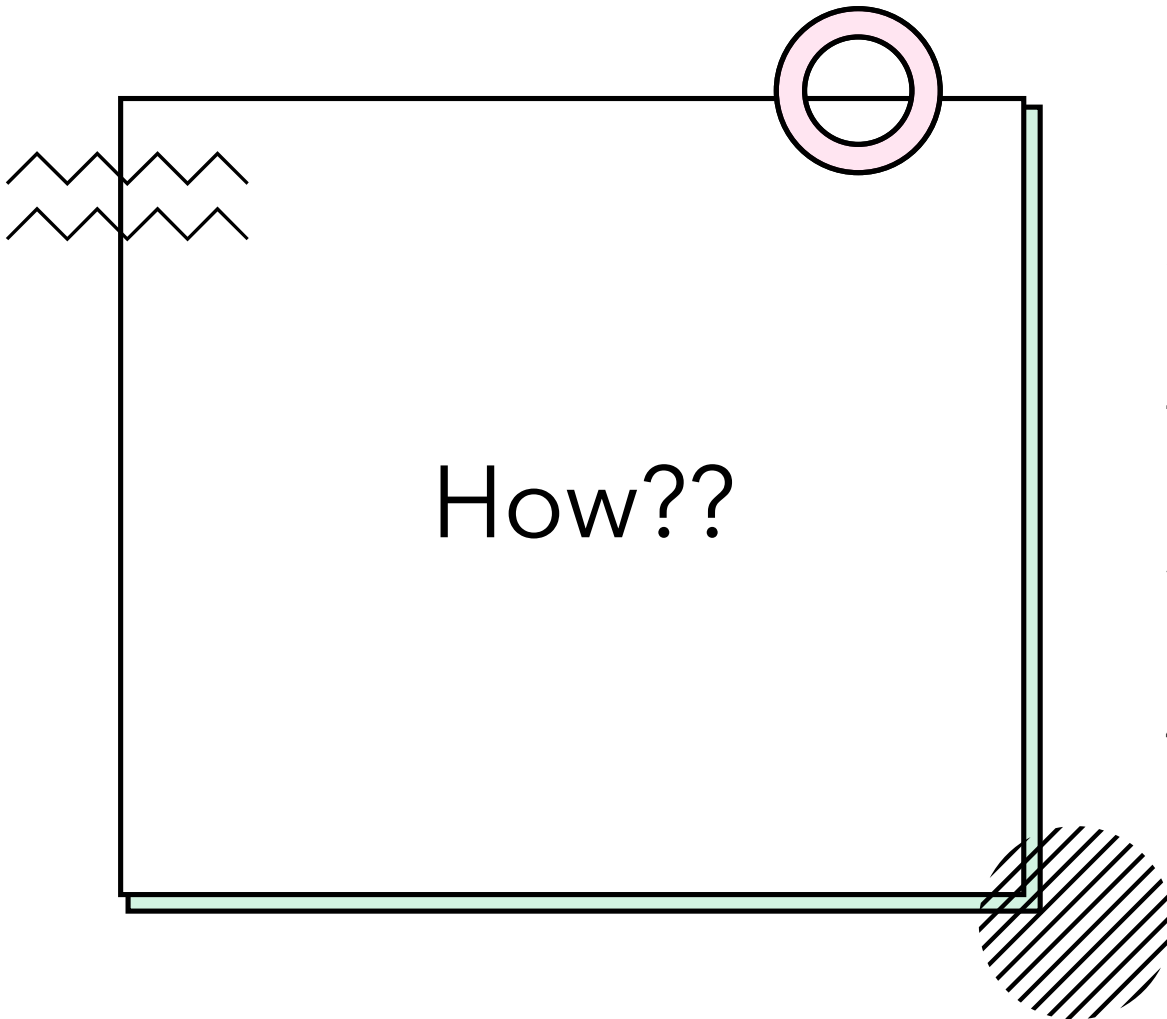

- Course Selection Period
- From 10:00 am, August 20 (Fri) to 4:00 pm, August 26 (Mon)
- Need to select courses for both semesters 1 and 2 among thousands of courses!!!
- Course info: available in HKU Portal after completing master registration with HKU

Note: pick your email address sensibly; you will use this for communication with prof/ intern application



Login HKU Portal

→ SIS (Student Information System)

1. **Enrollment > Enrollment Add Classes**
2. Select the appropriate term and courses to create **Temporary Course List**
3. Click "**Finish enrolling**" to confirm your selection (To be done during course selection period)
4. Check the results of your enrollment at "**View results**" page

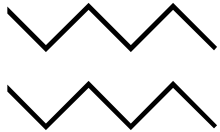

Two pathways for Major in Interdisciplinary Studies

- Two pathways, five courses each:
 - Cultures / Societies
 - Physical World / Biological / Human Sciences
- Faculties of Arts, Social Sciences, and Science
- Conditions:
 1. Under each pathway, no more than 2 courses under 1 faculty
 2. Same course can only be counted towards 1 pathway
 3. Courses counting towards Two Pathways cannot be counted towards another major/minor, vice versa

The course list is expandable; but you must list your course here and wait till approved and take it next year

Two pathways for Major in Interdisciplinary Studies

- The course list is expandable
- **BUT** you must t it approved by University before taking it
- Concentration:
 - We allow students to declare a “concentration” of your own choice
 - Signed by
 - Dean of Social Sciences &
 - BAsC Programme Director
 - Relevant to some social issues/ themes
 - More will be shared with later
 - Good to start thinking of whether there are courses that can make up a picture





Common Core Courses



- 4 courses in total
- One course each *Area of Inquiry*:
 - CCST Science, Technology and Big Data
 - CCHU Arts and Humanities
 - CCGL Global Issues
 - CCCH China: Culture, State and Society
- Course info:
 - Google "*hku common core*"
- Enrollment quota:
 - Google "*hku common core statistics*"





Other important info

1. Late Add/drop
 - Add/drop within the course selection period
 2. Study Load
 - Allowed: 24-36 credits per semester
 - Over/underloading requires special permission
 3. Chinese Language requirement
 - Can check if you are exempted
 - If so, you should take a 6-credit course as free elective

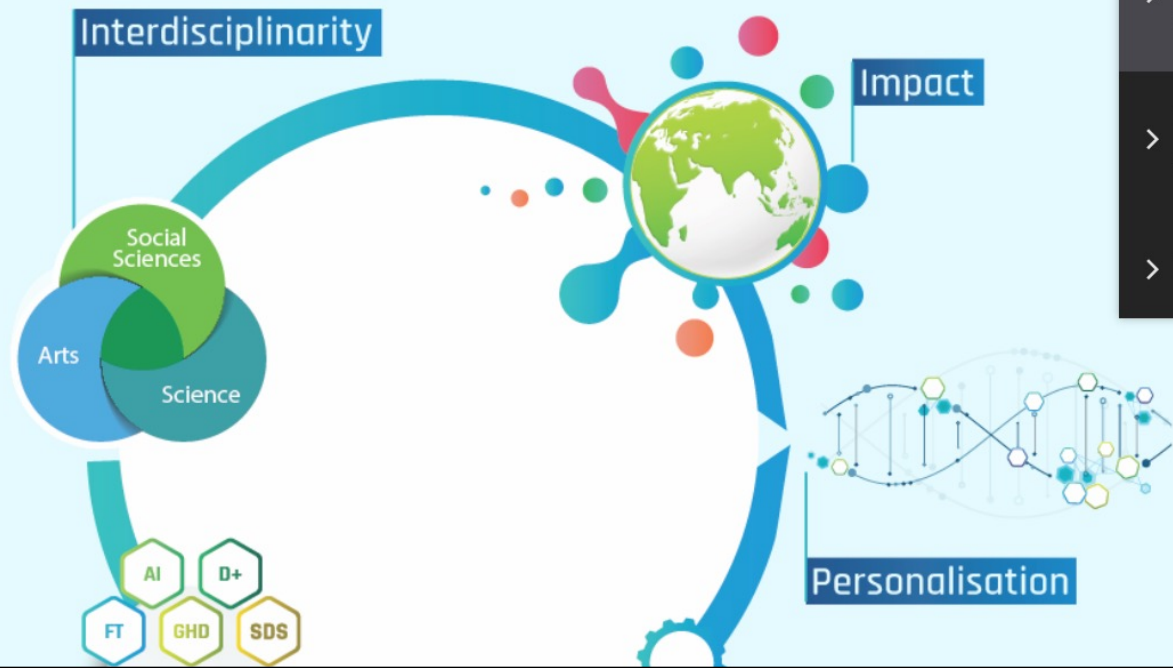
