

# Virtual Summer Internship Expo 2022

## User Guide for Gather Town Platform



## Overview

This year the Faculty of Social Sciences has developed a virtual space on the Gather Town platform for students to access the background information of Community Partners and internship descriptions for Summer Internship 2022 from **January 17 to January 26, 2022**.

Gather Town allows you to explore a customized virtual space where you can connect with other users through video calling. You can walk in and out of conversations like you would in real life -- and interact with objects to view posters, documents, and website links.

To interact with an object, walk up to it and press "X" on your keyboard to enter a full screen viewing.

### Chit-chat with Community Partners

Session 1: January 17 (Monday), 2022

Time: 3:00pm – 4:00pm



To facilitate communication between students and Community Partners, we will host two virtual chit-chat sessions on the platform.

Students can walk your avatar to visit different booths and interact with potential supervisors. We encourage students to join the chat to better understand the requirements, expectations and other additional information regarding the placements.

However, this session is not for interview purpose, students still need to apply formally through the Experiential Learning Application System.

## Getting Started

### Things to note before you start:

1. There is NO virtual background in GatherTown
2. Use your computer to connect; Mobiles/Tablets will not work
3. Get connected to your AC power
4. Recommend to use Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox, Safari may not be compatible
5. Find a quiet place with stable internet connectivity to ensure a very stable interact

### (1) Customize your Avatar

- Before entering our virtual space, Gather will ask you to customize your avatar's look and character name. We recommend that you use your English first name and surname initials for easier identification.

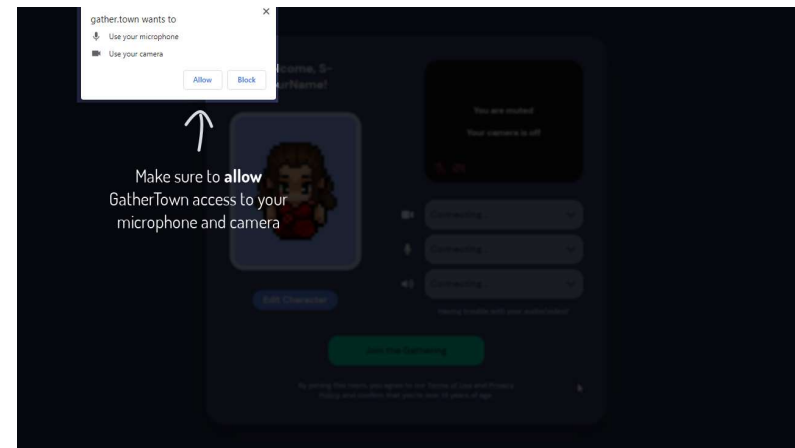
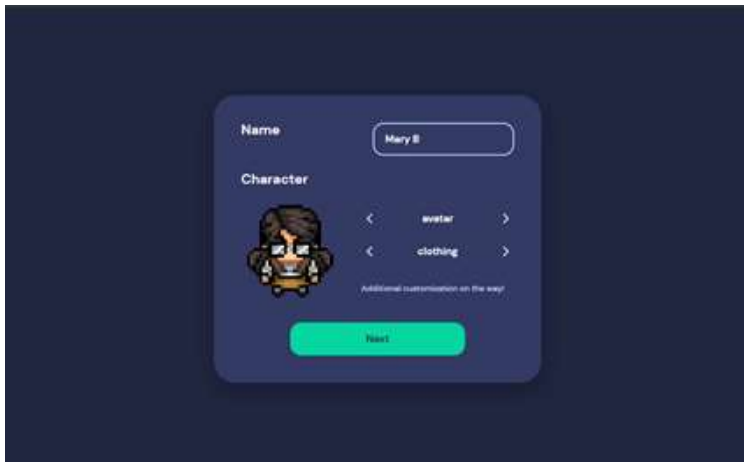
For Community Partners: **CP – Name (Organisation)** e.g. CP – Tom Chan (HKU)

For Students: **S – Name** e.g. S - Tom Chan

For Teachers: **T- Name** e.g. T - Tom Chan

- You will then be asked to allow browser access to your microphone and camera. We recommend using Chrome or Firefox for a smoother gathering experience.

*Tip: If you accidentally blocked Gather from accessing your microphone and camera, you can select the lock icon on the upper-left side of your site address bar to change your preferences.*



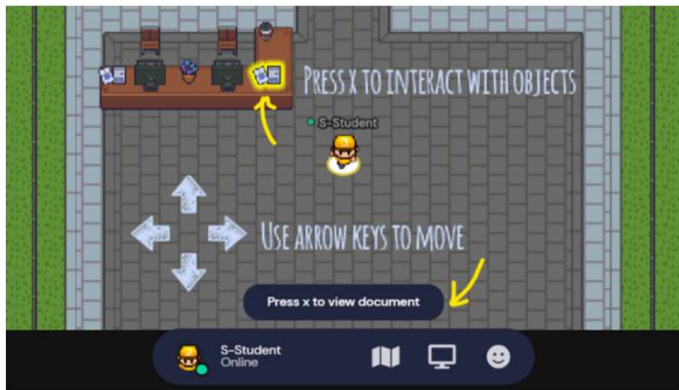
Select 'Allow' when the prompt asks for camera and microphone access

## Getting Started

### (2) User Interface

- Once inside our virtual space, you can move around by using the **arrow keys** on your keyboard.

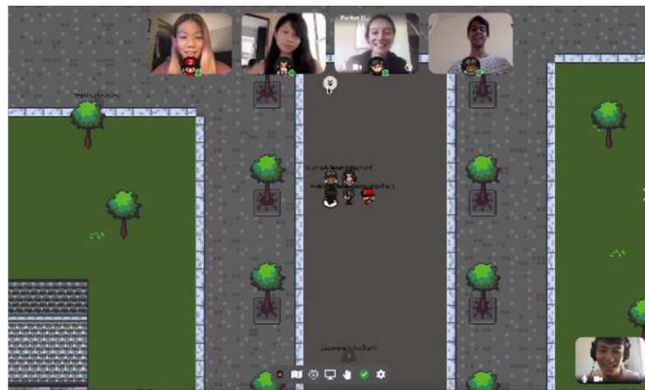
**Interactive objects** will be highlighted yellow and a prompt message will be displayed near the bottom action bar. Press 'X' to interact with it.



Interactive objects are highlighted in yellow when approached

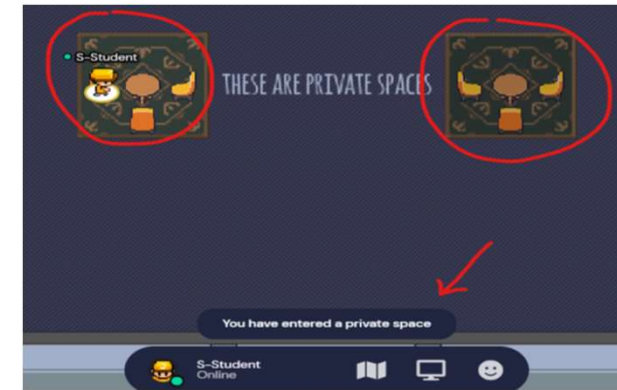
- When your avatar approaches others, a **video call** automatically starts between you and them. By default, anyone within the range of 5 tiles will show up on your video carousel

(unless in Quiet Mode where you will only see/hear the person next to you).

- If you are in a **Private area**, you will be connected to everyone inside that private area. When you enter a private area, the background will dim and a message prompt will let you know.

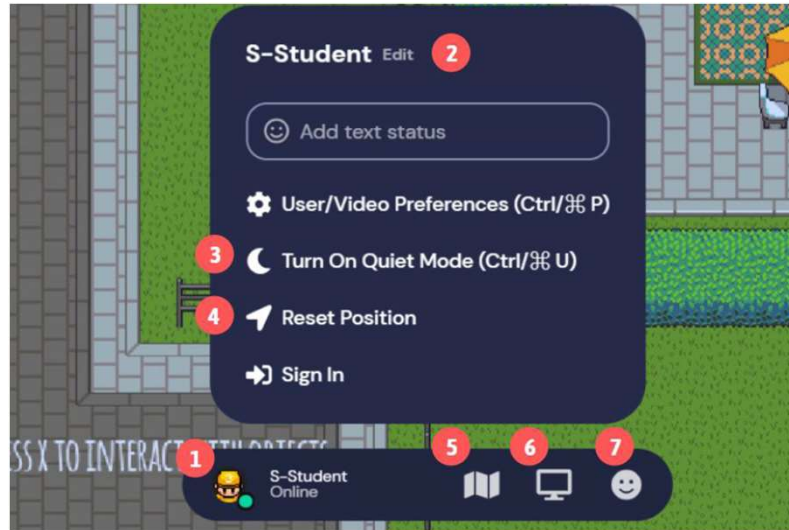


A message prompt will indicate that you have entered a private space

### (3) Functions

#### The Bottom Action Bar



The bottom action bar allows you access to the following functions:

1. Change character
2. Edit nickname
3. Toggle Quiet Mode
4. Reset Position
5. Mini-map
6. Screenshot
7. Emote

#### The Left Side Bar



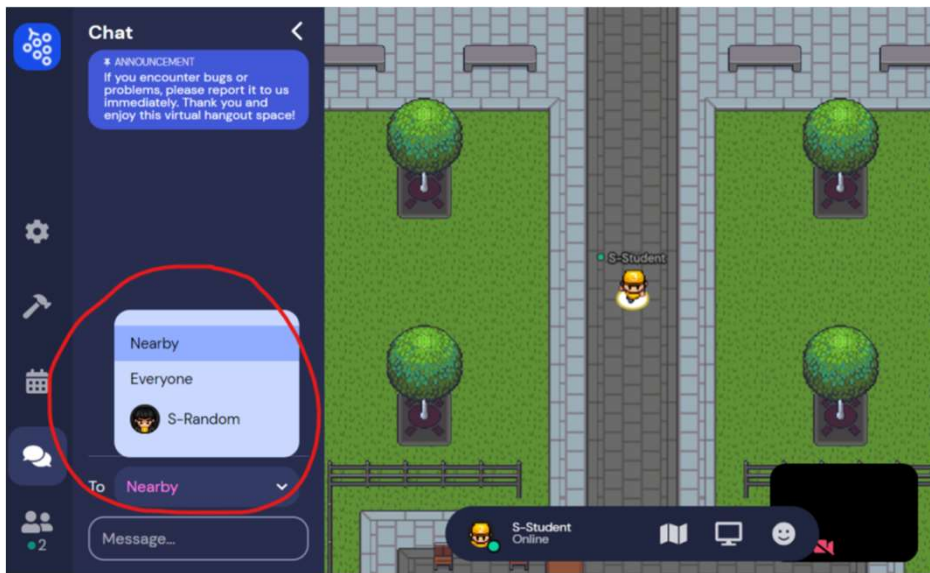
The left side bar houses the following actions:

1. Settings
2. Chat
3. Participants List

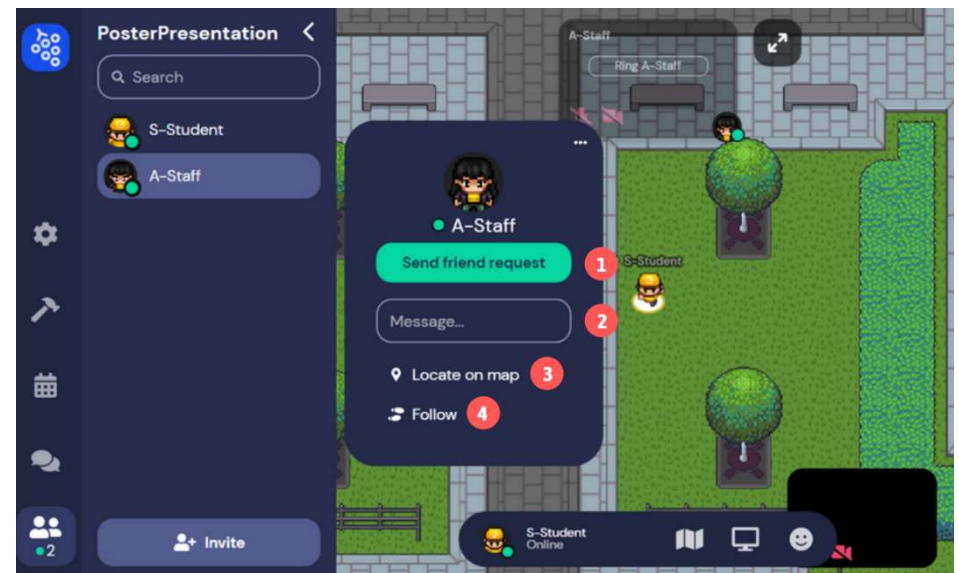
### (4) Chat with Someone

- The Chat bar will display important announcements, make sure to check from time to time. You can choose to send a message to people nearby, everyone, or any specific person.



- The Participants list shows everyone who is logged in to our virtual space. You can select a name and:

- add them as a friend
- send a message
- locate them on the map, or
- follow their avatar



Select any person from the Participants list and choose an action

## Getting Started

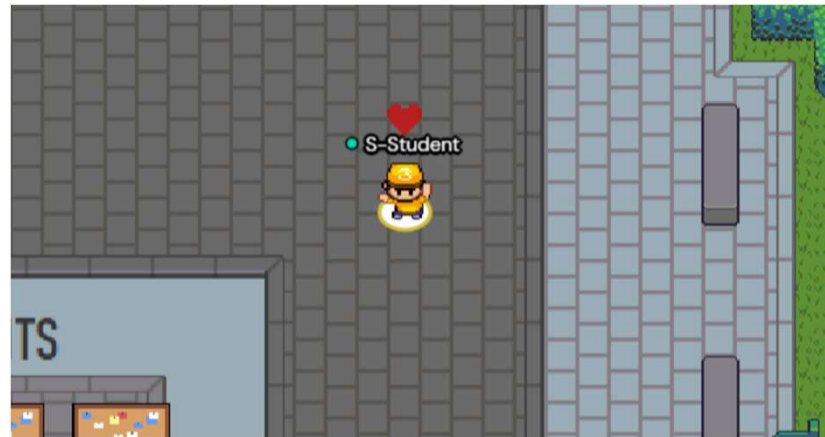
### (5) Advanced Features

- Is someone blocking your path? Or do you want to squeeze into a full private area? You can turn on the **ghost mode** by pressing 'G' on your keyboard!



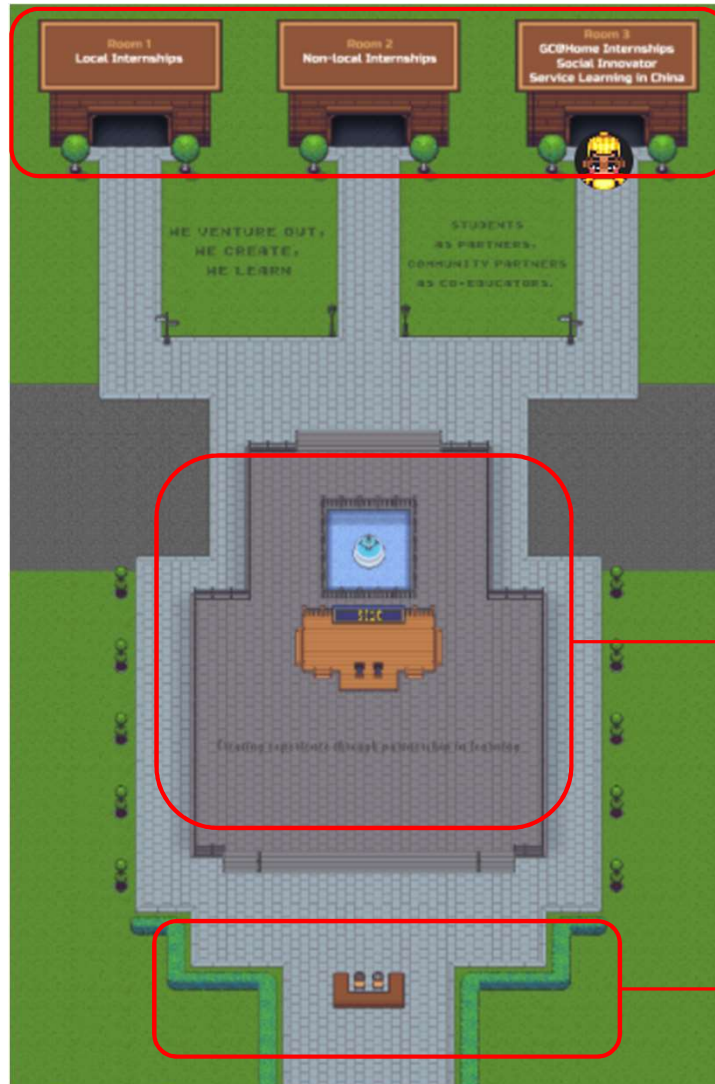
Press 'G' to turn into a ghost

- If you are feeling extra excited, you can make your avatar **dance** happily by pressing 'Z'.

### **Internship Exhibition**

The placements are categories into three main rooms:

Room 1 – Local Internships

Room 2 – Non-local Internships

Room 3 – Project-based Internships

Here is the general layout of our virtual space.

### **Main Stage**

This is where the opening will take place. It is also a common space for participants to interact with each other.

### **Reception Area**

This is where your avatar will start.

### Main Stage

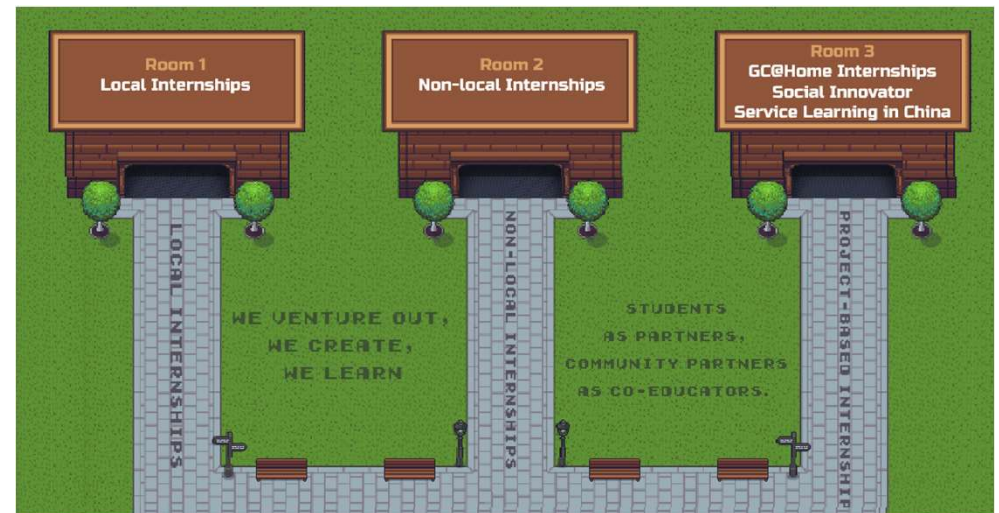

### Exhibition Rooms

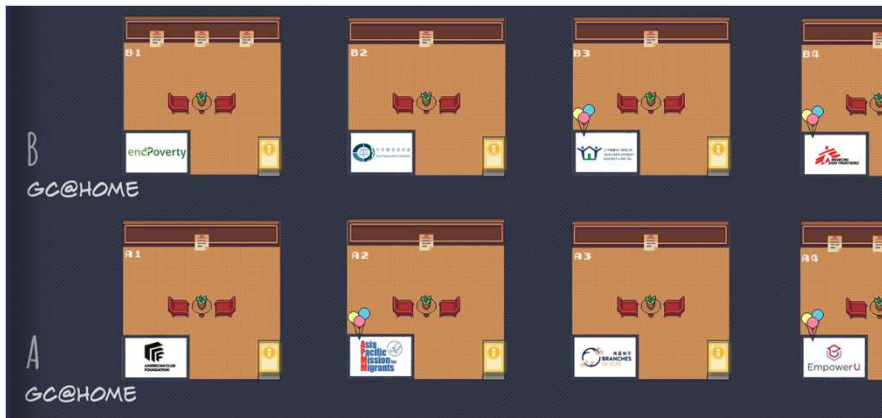



- Room 1: **Local Internships** – Community Partners will be categorized by **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** and then by alphabetical order
- Room 2: **Non-local Internships** – Community Partners will be categorized by **Continents**
- Room 3: **Project-based Internships** – Community Partners will be categorized by **Projects**

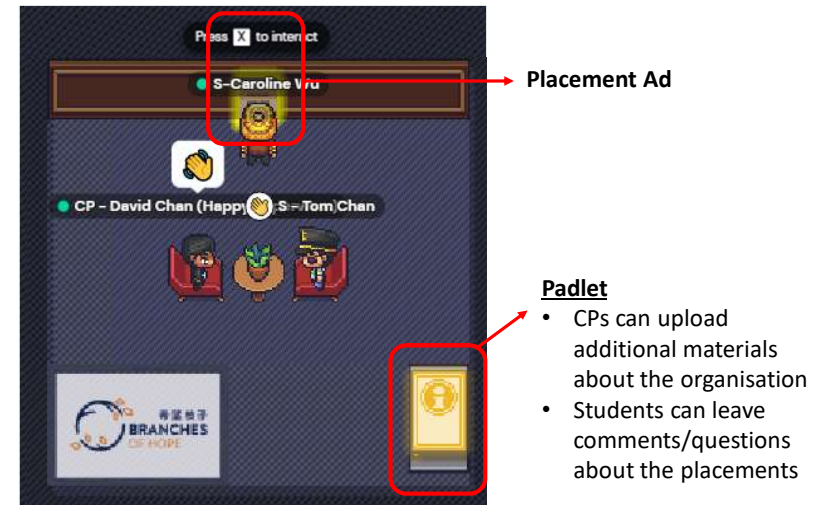
## Venue Map

### Booths inside the room



- You will be able to see the numbers (A, B, C, etc.) and categories for each row at the left-side of the room
- Each booth is assigned with a booth number (A1, A2, B1, B2, etc.) and the organisation's logo, so that participants can easily locate the booths
- For Community Partners who will be present at Gather Town during the chit-chat session(s), there will be  at the booths

### Individual Booth



Press "X" to interact with objects inside the booth, including:

- **View** Placement Ads (interact with folder at the top)
- **Post a comment** to CP (interact with Padlet at the right-hand corner)
- **Chat** with an avatar starts with "CP"
