In 2005, Sky co-founded a support network in Hong Kong for ethnically Chinese third culture teens. She is also a member of the World Economic Forum's Global Shaper Community, a TEDx speaker in Hong Kong, and since 2015 has been supporting HK welfare development as a Policy Research & Advocacy Standing Committee Member in the Hong Kong Council of Social Services. In 2017, Sky was nominated as a candidate for the AmCham HK Women of Influence Non-Profit Leader Award.
