

- > Financial Support
 - All accepted students reach the academic standard are eligible for HKUWW scholarship (subject to approval by IAO)
 - Up to HK\$15,000 to FOSS students (to be paid directly to Yonsei for the accommodation fee)
- > Pay HKU tuition fee + travel and living expenses
- ➤ Keio and Yonsei will assist in finding accommodation in Japan and South Korea













 Credits taken at Keio and Yonsei will be transferred back to HKU

- Memory booklet













Features of the internship course

From Early July, 2020 – Mid August, 2020





Student-initiated Internships

- To fit your interests and strengths
- To broaden existing internship opportunities
- Each student can propose only one Student-initiated Internship placement
- You should receive FORMAL APPROVAL from the Faculty BEFORE you start the Student-initiated Internship
- NO retrospective internship will be considered

Online application: Late October 2019 – November 2019











Supervision

Supervisor (Community Partner)

- Assign tasks that can stimulate learning;
- Provide clear instructions and adequate guidance;
- Have regular meeting with interns
- Provide an evaluation at the end of the internship

Academic Tutor (HKU, for 3 Campus only)

- Prepare interns for the internship through pre-internship orientation
- Facilitate CP supervisors' task setting and settle interns through visits to CPs in the first week
- Monitor interns' learning
- Evaluate through second visits if needed and evaluate written work









Internship Job Scope (for reference)

International commercial sector* -

To assist with a variety of tasks including data collection and analysis, gathering market feedback and product improvement for our suite of online products (Lexis HK, RED and Practical Guidance) used by major corporations, law firms and universities

^{*} Sometimes preferred by 3 Campus students









Internship Job Scope (for reference)

NGO –

To assist in research and development of material for example, sociopolitical landscapes and salient challenges facing by different jurisdictions (e.g., Burma, Iran, Kazakhstan, Vietnam, Cambodia)

Corporate Social Responsibility unit –

To assist in drafting and translating both internal and external communications materials, such as weekly wrap-up, intranet and website content, social media posts etc.

Memory Booklet

- Capture students' internship experience
- Printed as a booklet for souvenir to students
