The successful course enrollment record will be shown on the Student Information System (SIS) upon the approval from the department.
- 4. Students who wish to take the following courses are required to send an email to the course offering department for approval <u>two weeks</u> before the course enrollment period. Upon approval, the students should forward the approval email to the Faculty Office via email (<u>socii@hku.hk</u>) and the Faculty Office will enroll the course for you.
