

High Stakes, High Pressure

English proficiency is crucial for university admission.

• 45.3% of students fail to meet the English Lanugage requirement of UGC-funded 4-year tertiary institutions in HK - atleast a 3 in the HKDSE Examinations. (Hong Kong Examinations Assessment Authority (HKEAA), 2021)



Cross-age Peer-assisted Learning

- Informal pedagogical practice
- enables multifaceted **interactions'** for potentially marginalised children (Moriarty, 2017).

Project-Based Service Learning

- Organically improve critical thinking, teamwork, and social responsibility (Shi, 2024)
- The service-oriented nature of PBL prompts English proficiency through rewarding hands-on volunteerism (Lee et al., 2017).

Language Learning through Whole-Person Development

- Concerned with the general futurereadiness of students (Mollaei & Rahnama, 2012)
- encourages students to explore multiple intelligences and wellbeing through language practice (Derekhshan & Faribi, 2015).
